Votership



Your Power at the Ballot Box



Citizens Assembly

306 randomly selected citizens with authority over budgets, foreign aid, and military deployments



Direct Popular Vote

Electoral College Abolished. Direct popular vote for President. Rank Choice Voting for all federal elections.



Money Game Over

Contributions capped at \$1,000 per person. All corporate and organizational spending banned. Money is not speech. Citizens United overturned by constitutional mandate.



Shortened Campaigns

90 days total: 30-day primary, 60-day general. Elected officials spend their time governing, not attending fundraisers and rallies for years on end.



Fair Districts

Independent redistricting commissions in every state. Partisan gerrymandering prohibited.



Transparency

21-day public review of all legislation before any vote. All votes on the record. Searchable databases of every bill, vote, and lobbying contact.



Term Limits

House: 8 terms (16 years).
Senate: 2 terms (12 years).
Public service, not career entrenchment.



No Shutdowns

Budget failure triggers automatic funding and a snap election within 90 days. Every member of Congress and the President is replaced. The cost of failure is losing your seat.



Robust Representation

1:250,000 ratio for House representatives.
3 Senators per state.

Your Power in the Workplace



50:1 Pay Ratio

Highest paid employee cannot make more than 50 times the lowest wage employee



Living Minimum Wage

Sufficient for a single adult working full-time to afford housing, food, healthcare, and transportation. Adjusted annually.



Worker Board Representation

30% of board seats at companies with 100+ employees elected by workers.



Universal Worker Protections

Every worker covered regardless of immigration status. \$25,000 per worker per violation for exploitation.



Tipped Wage Eliminated

Full minimum wage for every worker. Tips are supplemental, not a substitute.



Card Check Recognition

Majority signs, employer recognizes in 30 days. No stalling tactics

The 50:1 Pay Ratio: \$400 Billion Back to Workers

Medicare for All: Better Care. Lower Cost. Everyone Covered. Fully Funded

| Dedicated Funding Sources | |

Drug Prices Capped

20% max markup above production cost (10% manufacturer, 5% prescriber, 5% pharmacy). Saves \$170B annually.



Water is a Right

First 50 gallons per person per day free. Cannot be shut off for non-payment of basic amount.



Predatory Lending Eliminated

25% cap on all consumer loan interest rates including credit cards. Payday lending banned.



Carbon Tax

\$50/ton CO2, escalating \$10/year. Revenue funds clean energy transition. Declines as emissions fall.



No Medical Bankruptcy

No more medical bankruptcy in this country.



Internet as Essential Utility

Internet with net neutrality is essential in our modern world. Say goodbye to the price gouging of necessities.

Universal Stock Ownership

If any employee gets stock, every employee gets stock in equitable shares.



First Refusal

When a business is sold or a factory closes, workers get first right to buy.



Employee-Ownership Incentives

Corporate tax codes that incentivize offering employee ownership of the company



Historical Rectification

\$2.52T over 15 years, community-controlled. Five councils per state. 100% community governance.



Home Ownership

Advancing individual home ownership and limiting corporate interference

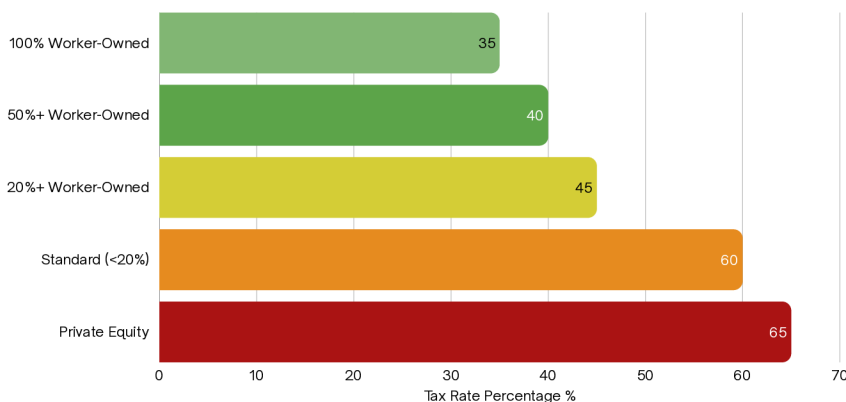


Community Controlled Resources

Policies that limit corporate control of essential resources and put them in control of communities

The New Architecture

Structural Reforms That Change the Rules

The Assemblic Branch

A new branch of government designed to enhance checks and balances. Comprising the Citizens Assembly, Indigenous Nations Assembly, and Island Nations Assembly with real power over budgets, legislation, and accountability.

Supreme Court Reform

11 justices. Single 22-year terms. Elected by the people through ranked choice voting. Three-branch nomination: President, Congress, and the Assemblic Branch each put forward one nominee. No campaigning. No partisan capture. Age cap of 50.

House and Senate Expansion

House: 1 representative per 250,000 citizens (~1,340 members). Senate: 3 per state (150 total). DC gets full house representation and 1 senator as a federal district. The people's house represents the people.

Indigenous Sovereignty

Indigenous Nations Assembly: 574 tribal delegates with veto power. Override requires 3/4 of Congress. \$50 billion annual trust funding. Land Restoration Fund: \$10B/year for 20 years. Plenary power abolished.

Territorial Self-Determination

Binding referenda for Puerto Rico, Guam, USVI, American Samoa, Northern Mariana Islands, and Hawaii. Statehood or Sovereignty. The people choose. Congress cannot override.

Independent Charters

Constitutional agencies for Votership, Consumership, Workership, Ownership, and Environmental protection. Independent from Congress. Cannot be defunded, overridden, or captured by politics.

Environmental Protection

\$500B clean energy transition over 10 years. Precautionary principle: prove safety first. Just Transition for fossil fuel workers: equivalent- wage jobs, retraining, 5-year wage protection.

Immigration

5.5 years from visa to citizenship. Six categories replacing 80+. Work visas belong to workers. One-time registration: 1+ year, \$500, immediate legal residency. Independent court. DACA: immediate status, no penalty.

Anti-Corruption

Stock trading ban for all officials. Gift ban (\$25 max). 10-year lobbying ban. Corporate lobbying prohibited. 5-year post-service employment ban. Inaugurations funded by taxpayers only.

Partnership Standards

Five-tier classification for every nation. To trade with America: free elections, individual freedoms, and sovereignty respect. Independent commission evaluates. Politicians cannot override.

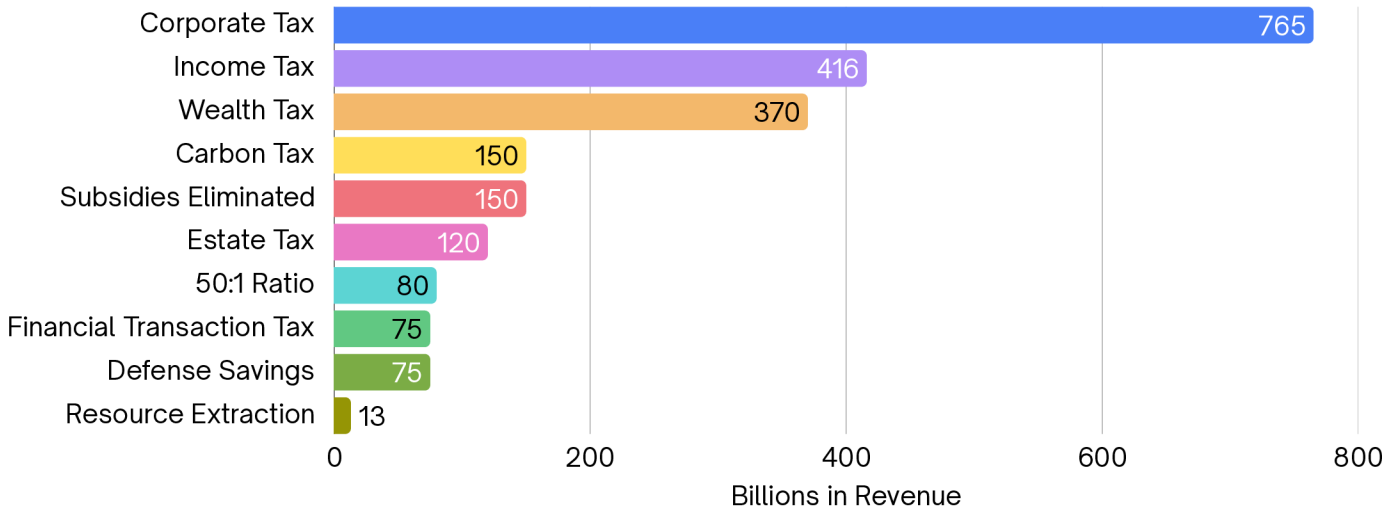

The Math Works

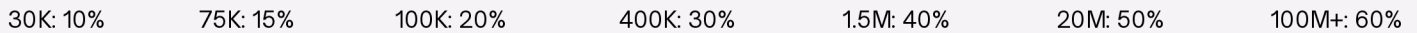


\$2.2 - \$2.7 Trillion in Progressive Revenue

98% of Americans get a tax cut. The revenue comes from the top 2% and large corporations



Income Tax



The first \$30,000 taxed at just 10%. No one under \$100,000 pays more than 20% on any dollar. Middle wage-earners can expect a low tax bill along with zero premiums, zero deductibles, and higher wages.

What changes for you as a result of the new tax code, medicare for all, and wage policies:

- A retail worker making \$25,000 a year is **+\$9,268/year better off**
- A teacher making \$50,000 is **+\$4,213/year better off**
- A nurse bringing home \$75,000 is **+\$3,963/year better off**
- An engineer with a salary of \$100,000 is **+\$3,463/year better off**

Years 1-5
\$1.0 - 1.6T

Years 6-10
\$1.0 - 1.6T

Years 11-15
\$1.5 - 2.0T

Years 16-20
\$1.7 - 2.3T

Surplus at every phase. Medicare for All entirely self-funded on top of this.

- 6. Sustain the Pressure.** Plan for sustained weeks-long protest and strike. The Civil Rights Act took a decade. Transformation requires persistence.
- 7. Demand These Reforms.** When the pressure is applied, it is important to vocalize what we want. A stronger democracy and a just economy. These frameworks can achieve that.
